REFERENCE LIST - CONVENTIONS		
List in numerical order at the end of the work.		
One to six authors: List all authors names and separate each by a comma		
More than six authors: list the first three authors, followed by et al.		
Journal names are abbreviated according to NLM PubMed Journals catalogue: https://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/nlmcatalog/journals/
