Skip the stress,

If you're a Year 12 student who is serious about getting into uni, skip the stress with UniSC's Early Offer Guarantee

What is the Early Offer Guarantee?

The Early Offer Guarantee is for Year 12 students who want to secure their university spot early. This early offer reduces the pressure of Year 12, allowing you to finalise your university plans before your final exams and assessments. You'll have more time to prepare for the year ahead and can relax knowing your university place is locked in.

How does it work?

To apply for an early offer, you'll need your school Principal's approval. Your Principal will consider your academic performance, motivation to succeed, and personal qualities like your interests, passion and talents.

You don't need to be ATAR eligible to apply, but you do need to demonstrate a level of academic performance and potential in line with the ATAR/rank minimum selection threshold for your preferred program. If your Year 12 results show you're on track to succeed in gaining entry to your preferred program and you have the right level of motivation and commitment, you can secure an offer before final results and ATARs are released.

If you receive an early offer, it doesn't mean you can take your foot off the pedal with your high school studies. You'll need to keep attending classes and successfully complete Year 12 to be eligible for an early offer. You'll also need to meet all course prerequisites and other program specific requirements.

Why apply?

- ✓ Gain early entry to a UniSC program based on your academic potential, motivation, skills, talents and passion.
- ✓ Don't wait for your Year 12 results or the QTAC offer rounds in December or January — relax and enjoy your summer holidays knowing uni is sorted.
- ✓ If things haven't gone quite to plan and you're worried about your results, uni is still within reach.
- ✓ Start making plans for next year — now!
- ✓ Access UniSC support services as soon as you have received your offer, including pre-semester academic skills and career advice.

How to apply

1 Choose your program

To search for programs, go to usc.edu.au/programs or check out the UniSC Study Guide. Remember, you need to meet all course prerequisites and other program-specific requirements for your chosen program*.

2 Complete your Early Offer Guarantee application

Download the UniSC Early Offer Guarantee application form found at usc.edu.au/early-offer and meet with your Early Offer Guarantee Coordinator within your school.

3 Complete your QTAC application

Complete your QTAC application ensuring that your first preference matches the program you've nominated on your Early Offer Guarantee application. QTAC applications open **1 August 2024**.

* **Exceptions:** The Bachelor of Biomedical Science (Accelerated), Bachelor of Dietetics (Honours), Bachelor of Physiotherapy (Honours), Bachelor of Medical Science, Bachelor of Midwifery and Bachelor of Music are not available via this program.

4 Submit your application to QTAC and UniSC

You'll need to submit both your QTAC application and Early Offer Guarantee application to be eligible to receive an early offer. Your QTAC application must be submitted prior to submitting your Early Offer Guarantee application form. Your QTAC application must be submitted by **30 September 2024**. Submit your UniSC application with a copy of your most recent progress report or report card to your school's Early Offer Guarantee Coordinator before **7 October 2024**.

5 Receive your offer

UniSC will be making offers fortnightly from 6 September to 15 November, however no offers will be made during the Year 12 external examination period. When your UniSC application has been finalised, you will receive notifications via email from QTAC and from UniSC with all the information you need to enrol in your classes and get ready for a flying start to your first semester at UniSC.

All early offers will be conditional on you completing Year 12 and meeting any subject prerequisites, so make sure you keep attending class and complete your exams.
